IMPRESS YOUR BOSS Haskell Aeon Shiraz 2013

Mint and dark chocolate, with hints of leather and spice on the nose. The palate has fine tannins which end balanced and savoury. Good balance between fruit and wood. R350



BRAAIMASTER Glenelly Estate Reserve 2012

Rich powerful aromas of red fruits, plum and blackberries, followed by hints of savoury, spicy Syrah with touches of cedar and floral tones. The palate has good richness and firm, balanced tannins. R150



HOT OFF THE COALS Bonfire Hill Extreme Vineyards Red

An intriguing blend of red summer fruits, spring fynbos flowers, spice and toasty oak. The palate is surprisingly decadent, with almost creamy tannins. Well balanced and refreshing. R85
